Vista Reservoir No. 2 Rehabilitation

Vista Reservoir, a 300,000-gallon reservoir located at the top of the 1,630 pressure zone, is a critical component of the District's water distribution system. Due to the lack of redundancy, MSWD has proposed a second reservoir at the existing 1.23-acre Vista Reservoir site, located along Valencia Drive in the City of Desert Hot Springs. The project includes the installation of a new 300,000-gallon water storage reservoir and related piping, approximately 30 feet northwest of the existing reservoir, retaining walls and hillside slope stabilization, stormwater management BMPs, a new access road, relocation of the existing hydropneumatics station and electrical cabinet, grading, and wrought iron and chain link fencing.

The addition of a second reservoir will allow for redundancy at the site and for the rehabilitation of the existing reservoir without affecting service to our customers.
