Water and Wastewater System Master Plan Updates

MSWD's Water and Wastewater Master Plans are essential tools in identifying current and future system improvements. They allow the District to plan for and meet the ever-changing/growing water and wastewater needs within our service area. The current plans were completed 2005 and 2007, and since that time several projects identified in them have been implemented. This combined with regulatory changes and new District produces that govern how we store, manage, and treat water, dictate that a comprehensive update is necessary.
