You are receiving this letter from Mission Springs Water District (District) because we have made an initial determination that your facility may be required to hold a Sewer Interceptor Waste Discharge Permit (a Qualified Facility) - as defined in the District's Sewer Ordinance for sand or grease traps. The best way to confirm whether your business or facility is a Qualified Facility is for the District to perform an onsite inspection. There is no charge for this initial onsite evaluation visit.

You can contact the District's Wastewater Department at 760 329-6278 at your earliest convenience to set up an appointment to have the onsite evaluation completed. If your facility is confirmed to be a Qualified Facility, the District will provide a follow-up notice in December that will include instructions on the process of applying for a Sewer Interceptor Permit.

Please contact the District's Wastewater Department within the next (30) thirty calendar days to schedule a site visit of your facility.
